GRANTS AVAILABLE FOR STEWARDSHIP COSTS in the GREAT BAY WATERSHED

The Great Bay Resource Protection Partnership announces Stewardship Grant Program Spring 2026

Durham, NH – Grant applications are available for the Great Bay Resource Protection Partnership’s Spring 2026 Stewardship Grant Program. The grants program assists with land stewardship costs for the permanently protected conservation lands in the Great Bay watershed area of New Hampshire.

Stewardship activities supported by this grant program include habitat management, existing trail maintenance, property/project planning, and natural resource inventory projects. Projects that involve resource sharing or collaboration with partners/abutters on stewardship actions across property boundaries are encouraged. For 2026 applications, professional services to develop the SGP application maybe eligible as a reimbursable grant cost or project match cost.

Eligible applicants include the fee owner or conservation easement holder of an eligible conservation property, including qualified nonprofit tax-exempt 501(c)(3) conservation organizations, municipalities and units of government.
